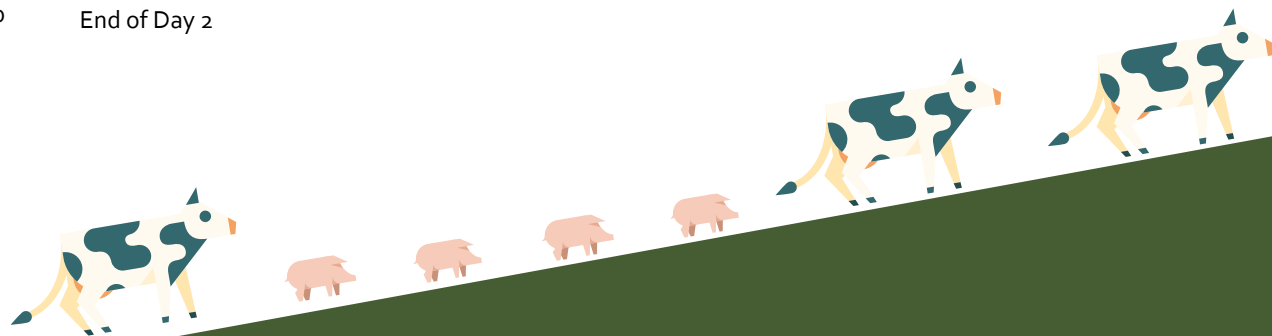

The small print

The workshop is free of charge. Registration is required in writing per fax or e-mail. After receiving your complete registration we will send you the confirmation with the details. Your registration is binding. In case of illness or force majeure you may send a substitute participant.

Within the project funds are available for supporting accommodation and travel costs for maximum 20 experts from European non-project-partner countries. Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Travel costs:

Eligible travel costs are economy class flights within Europe. The participant will make his/her own the travel arrangements. After completion of the training course the participant may hand in the invoice and proof of travel (e.g. boarding passes) to reclaim the travel costs. Be aware, that costs will only be reimbursed, if the proof of travel is handed in. Transport to and from the airport as well as local travel during the training course have to be paid by the participant. Exempt from this is the visit to a small scale biogas plant, where IBBK will organise a bus.

Accommodation:

IBBK will book the hotel for the participant for a maximum of 3 nights, depending on the flight schedule. Further costs arising for overnight stays have to be paid by the participant. Any costs arising for the use of the minibar or any other services offered by the hotel have to be covered by the participant.

Food and Catering:

Costs for breakfast at the hotel will be covered by the project. Coffee-breaks and lunch are included in the training course. Any costs beyond those mentioned, e.g. dinner costs, will not be covered by the project.
